I am excited to be an Infoscion. Before I go into details, I would like to thank Chitkara Management Cell for their training sessions at sec-9, Chandigarh. The training module at Chandigarh proved to be multifarious considering for today's highly competitive world scenario. It acted as a mentor which leads to magnificent success to CIETians.

The material was fully panoramic and the lectures highly informative. Different sessions for personality development, group discussions and mock interview sessions were an added attraction and ensured proper nourishment of my ideas. At the very initial stage, I was worried whether I would be able to cope up with the pressure of 7 days week schedule or not. But slowly it became a routine. The Infosys test consisted of two sections, logical reasoning (30 questions/ 40 minutes) and the English section (40 questions/ 30 minutes), which one can only solve with practice, practice and nothing else. Going through the previous placement question papers on internet proved helpful. As far as the interview was concerned, the HR interviewer enquired about my hobbies, which I had mentioned in my resume. He, also put some puzzles to solve and asked some situation based questions. For the puzzles, one must be thorough with books authored by Shakuntala Devi and George Summers.

Following points can be important for the aspirants.

- Always be regular to attend lectures.
- Updating the knowledge is another tool. Reading English national daily, CSR are a must, especially to know the latest in the field of specialization.
- When one wants to appear in an interview, one must abreast himself or herself with company profile you appearing for.
- Confidence is the key. When you are tense, you may give wrong answers to questions asked by interviewer.
- Be consistent, sincere and honest in your preparation. Last moment revision may be helpful.
- Give due respect to the teachers. Their guidance, encouragement, blessings and best wishes are always a boon.
- Be thorough and truthful about your resume. Please don't add phrases or the terms just to impress the interviewer. Remember, your Resume is the basis of your interview.
- Listen to pre-placement talk carefully, as this forms a part of your HR interview questions.
- Go for self study, hard work, exact and effective expressions of answers in a concise manner.
- Seniors also act as advisors as they are more experienced. Taking some tips from them can be helpful.

Piece of advice for my friends, who have not made it, please don't loose heart. It is not the end of the world. Many more and better opportunities may be destined for you.

Rest of the work depends on the way one communicates with the interviewer. Its God's grace that takes you to the top of the world. So always remember Him.
