Free training for minimum 8th Class Pass students of Punjab in the age group of 18-28 years for skilled employment

The Ministry of Tourism, Government of India and Punjab Heritage Tourism Promotion Board, have launched some short job-oriented training programmes to create emplopyable skills in hospitality trades, which will be conducted at the designated Institutes of Hotel Management. In this regard, courses in the undermentioned trades will be conducted at Chitkara School of Hospitality, which is affiliated to National Council for Hotel Managaement and Catering Technology, at its Jansla (Rajpura) campus for the Year 2015-16:-

The courses would be conducted in the batch size of 25 to 30 candidates and the selection would be from the applications received on first come first serve basis. While there will be no course fee, students would be paid stipend of Rs. 2,000/- for 8-week and Rs. 1,500/- for 6-week courses upon attaining minimum 90% attendance. Besides stipend students will also be given tool kit, uniform and lunch free of cost. Upon completion of the course, a test would be conducted by the National Council for awarding certificates. The School will make conscious effort to facilitate employment of the pass-outs from this programme.

Interested candidates may send their applications along with two passport size photographs, minimum 8th class pass certificate and a proof of their date of birth, to the Director-Principal, Chitkara School of Hospitality, Jansla (Rajpura) at the earliest.
