The Anti-ragging Squad shall work in co-ordination with the Anti-ragging committee and oversee the implementation of the recommendations.

Punishments: Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the Institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

1. Cancellation of admission.
2. Suspension from attending classes.
3. Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
4. Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process
5. Withholding results.
6. Debarring from representing the University in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
7. Suspensions/ expulsion from the hostel.

8. Rustication from the University for period varying from 1 to 4 semester.
9. Expulsion from the University and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution/University.
10. Fine up to Rs. 25,000/-
11. Collective punishment:- When the persons committing or abetting the crime or ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

As per the instruction of UGC / Supreme Court of India, each of the student of the Institute and his/her parents and, or Guardian are hereby required to submit an undertaking at the time of registration/admission, in the prescribed format as attached to this order, which is mandatory for registration/admission.
