#### CIRCULAR

Sub:-Formation of Institute level anti-ragging committee and squads – Reg.

**Ref:** Directives of the Supreme Court of India, dated May 16, 2007 in SLP No.(s)24295of2006 University of Kerala Vs Council, Principals', Colleges, Kerala & Ors (with SLP(C) No. 24296-99/2004 & W.P. (Crl.) No. 173/2006 and SLP(C) No. 14356/2005) and Government of Himachal Pradesh letter no. EDNA-A-Ka(3)-6/2009 dated 1<sup>st</sup> June 2009.

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As per the directions of Supreme Court of India/UGC, the University has formed the following Anti-ragging committees and squads for overseeing the implementation of the provisions of the verdict with immediate effect:

## 1) Anti-ragging Committee:

# 2) Anti-ragging Squad:

The Anti-ragging Squad shall work in co-ordination with the Anti-ragging committee and oversee the implementation of the recommendations.

**Punishments:** Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the University, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the University level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- 1. Cancellation of admission.
- 2. Suspension from attending classes.
- 3. Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
- 4. Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process
- 5. Withholding results.
- 6. Debarring from representing the University in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- 7 Suspensions/ expulsion from the hostel.
- 8. Rustication from the University for period varying from 1 to 8 trimester.
- 9. Expulsion from the University and consequent debarring from admission to any other University.
- 10. Rigorous imprisonment of three years and / or a fine of upto Rs. 25,000/-
- 11. Collective punishment:- When the persons committing or abetting the crime or ragging are not identified, the University shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

As per the instruction of UGC / Supreme Court of India, each of the student of the Institute and his/her parents and, or Guardian are hereby required to submit an affidavit at the time of registration/ admission, in the prescribed format as attached to this order, which is mandatory for registration/admission.
