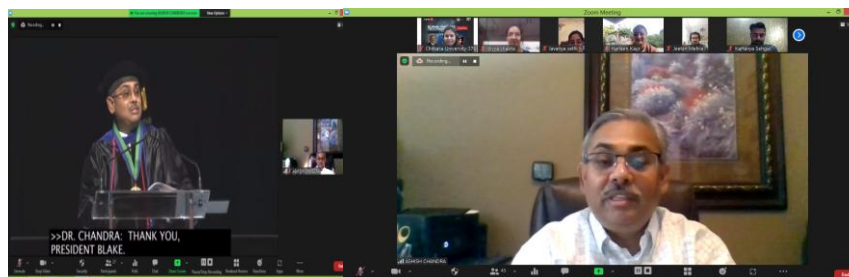
#### About the Activity
