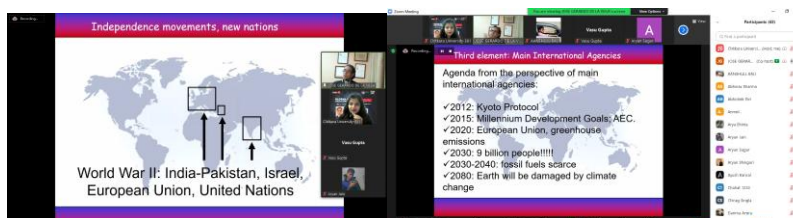
#### About the Activity

The session was conducted by the resource person- Dr. Jose Gerardo De la vega Meneses, professor of accounting and finance from UPAEP University Mexico. In his sessions Professor Jose talked about independence movements of different countries, how the new nations have emerged during world War I and world war II. He also covers the important event during the first decade of 21<sup>st</sup> century like September 11 attack, Tsunami, 2004; Lehman brothers bankruptcy 2008 etc. He discussed the role of various development agencies like central banks, development banks and space agencies globally in uplifting the nation’s economy. After discussing about the historical aspects, he took the discussion to current pandemic situation, how it has affected the economies of various countries and what will be the future outlook. In his sessions Professor Jose also talked about various methods that indicate the financial stability of a country. He discussed and decoded a report of World Bank with the students which talks about the global economic prospects.
