Project Title- "DownDetect- A Breakthrough in Down Syndrome Early Detection"

PHARM D III year students (Sapna Ahuja and Khushi Lamba) under the guidance of faculty members designed a Down syndrome detection kit, designed for early screening of Down syndrome in the first trimester. Utilising a dual testing approach of biomarkers—free beta hCG and unconjugated estriol—this kit provides heightened sensitivity and specificity compared to traditional methods for identifying trisomy 21. By analysing maternal urine samples, this innovative solution eliminates the need for invasive procedures, ensuring safety and comfort for both mother and foetus. Employing colourimetry and fluorimetry principles, our kit delivers rapid and accurate results, empowering expectant parents with vital information about their baby's health. This device presents significant commercial potential with its non-invasive design, user-friendly interface, and enhanced precision. It offers healthcare professionals and parents a reliable early Down syndrome detection tool, potentially improving prenatal care and informed decision-making. Moreover, its dual detection method and incorporation of fluorescence technology make it a promising option for adoption in clinics, hospitals, and prenatal care facilities globally.




INTERNATIONAL VISITS






