





Social, professional, or interpersonal consequences can include:

- Becoming pregnant while using drugs and harming the fetus and newborn baby.
- Jeopardizing relationships with friends and family.
- Neglecting work and school responsibilities.
- Involvement in criminal activity and a greater risk of being victimized by crime.

The following groups of factors have been described as the barrier for women's advancement in medicine: reinforcement of traditional gender roles, discrimination and lack of effective mentoring. Suggested approaches to address these obstacles include: creating supportive female networks among students and practitioners, peer mentoring, using gender-sensitive language and designing good working conditions. As a strategy towards achieving gender equality in health, the importance of educating medical students and practitioners in gender analysis and gender sensitive programming is suggested. Gender analysis contributes to the understanding of differentials in: risk factors and exposures; manifestation, severity and frequency of diseases; and social and cultural responses to diseases. In promoting the modernisation and reforms of the medical curricula, we need to promote training of medical students and health care professionals in gender issues. Understanding the influence of gender roles and gender relations on health is crucial in adequate response of the health sector to the health needs of both women and men. From this workshop we learned that gender equality matters for health. It is one of the most important drivers of health and health inequalities of our time. Beyond quantitative gender equality, we must strive for a cultural transformation that allows for the inclusion of values of transparency, honesty, fairness, and justice. With the evolving landscape, we are in the position to demand more from the evidence, to innovate beyond current discourses, and to realise true gender equality for everyone, everywhere. Achieving gender equality is not simply instrumental for health and development, its impact has wide-ranging benefits and is a matter of fairness and social justice for everyone. WORKSHOP ON "DISASTER RISK ASSESSMENT OF THE BANK SQUARE AREA OF SECTOR 17 CHANDIGARH"

Date: 7-8th November 2014

Chitkara School of Planning and Architecture organized a workshop on "Risk assessment of the Bank square area of Sector 17 Chandigarh", on 7-8th November, 2014. The case study area is part of the southern zone reserved for the district administration and is home to all important nationalized banks and other offices. This results in high density of people and vehicles making it vulnerable to various types of hazards like fire, theft, etc. 90 students in 13 groups of CSPA worked in workshop.

The aim of the workshop was to assess disaster risks in the buildings and spaces in and around the Bank Square, thus applying and testing the theory learnt in this subject of disaster risk assessment. The study was carried out through on site observation, interviews with bank officials, fire officers, and people from municipality. Documentation for various issues related to the subject was also carried out. Initial observations showed that some banks were well informed and equipped for the main hazard they anticipate, the fire and theft/burglary but many others are not. In fact a major rethought needs to be done at site level, .where it is almost impossible to manoeuvre a car, let alone a fire engine.

EXHIBITION ON"DISASTER RISK ASSESSMENT OF THE BANK SQUARE AREA OF SECTOR 17 CHANDIGARH" Date: 4-5th December 2014.

Chitkara School of Planning and Architecture had a Jury for the work done by the students as part of the Workshop on, "Risk assessment of Bank square, Sector 17, Chandigarh". 90 students in 13 groups exhibited their sheets and the viva was conducted over two days on 4-5th Dec, 2014.

With over 100 sheets on display, approximately 30 banks, one eatery joint and some private offices were covered for the study. Each building block was analyzed at various floor levels for its vulnerability to hazards that included faulty wiring, encroached balconies, cracks, lack of fire fighting systems and many more. The areas surrounding the buildings were also thoroughly studied for the issues related to emergency evacuation, access of emergency vehicles i.e fire engine, ambulance and police vehicle, existing parking, vegetation etc. Over and above field investigation, the students also formulated proposals for structural and non structural mitigation measures.

Dr. K.K Sharma, Head of Department, BBA-B Com/ Chitkara Business School reviewed the work. Dr Sharma has been associated with the field of disaster management through his work at UN level. He listened to all the groups with utmost patience and the students benefited immensely from his questions and feedback. He was impressed by the in-depth analysis and quality of work. Dr. Sharma, Prof. IJS Bakshi(Director, CSPA) and Prof Surjit Bais(Principal, CSPA) also stressed that the work should be presented to the people working in the banks. This would be useful information for them to make the place disaster safe.

On the third day, the first lecture was started by Neha Singh, Asst Prof, Chitkara School of Planning & Architecture. She is also a National Player in Lawn Tennis. Her lecture was on importance of Sports & Time Management. It was very knowledgeable for our NSS Volunteers as she told them such techniques which they can use during their academics. After tea break, there was a next lecture on "Prevention against Ebola Virus" by Ruchi Singhal, Asst Prof, Chitkara College of Pharmacy. This session was very informative as she spoke about this dangerous disease which transfers from person to person through sweating and body fluids and can cause death in 7 days. Right now, this disease is prevalent in Africa and had not yet entered India. If it comes to India, then, it will be a big disaster for the society. So, she told us about various precautions & preventions we should take if this disease occurs. Lastly, the day ended with a workshop on "Fire Fighting" held by the experts from Fire station, Rajpura. Our volunteers were educated with various firefighting techniques and a demonstration was given on fire alarm, different types of fire extinguishers and how they work and were also shown live how to stop the fire. So this day concluded very well.

The fourth day was very educative & informative for all of us. The day started with a seminar on Drug abuse by Dr. Gurpreet Singh, Associate Professor in Mechanical Engineering, Department. YCOE, Punjabi University, Patiala. He enlightened us about how drug addiction has spread widely in Punjab and all over India. It was shocking for all of us to hear that Punjab, being a religious place, is the most addicted in Drugs especially in Amritsar. He showed video how drugs get transferred from Pakistan to Punjab and then to Delhi and its price hike and about small children involved in drugs addiction. It was an eye opening & motivating session. We all took a pledge to stop this social evil of drugs at domestic level first. After lunch break, the day concluded by clothes collection for Donation and

Interaction with Local Labours on the topics like drug de-addiction, hygiene, education, etc. and to live a positive life.

The day five was led by a lecture on Disaster Management by Ms. NiyatiJigyasu, Associate Professor, Chitkara School of Planning & Architecture. She informed us about the causes, prevention and mitigation strategies for different disasters. We were informed about the aftereffects and safety measures to be taken after a disaster occurs. Later, after the break, we went for an interactive session with the students of Govt. High School, Jhansla. We all noticed that they were very happy & excited like us when we met them. We got to know about their interests, aims or what they want from their life. Some of our volunteers spoke on various topics like health, hygiene, sports, etc and informed them to help them out, so that, they have a better future ahead. Then, we all moved to Chitkara Sewing Centre. We all interacted with them and got to know that they all have financial crises and really work hard for their livelihood. Then the volunteers went for the survey in Jhansla village to know about their perspective of life and what improvements they want in their village. Village people discussed their problems and the main motive was on drug deaddiction. 10% population of Jhansla village is drug or alcohol consumer. Thus, our volunteers got awareness about the ratio of drug/alcohol addicted persons and were motivated to take initiative to work on this issue.

On day sixth, we had a very interesting interactive session on importance of Hindi by Dr. Sangeeta Pant, Dean, Chitkara College of Education for Women, C.U. (Pb). She discussed on topics like creativity, stress, etc. It was an activity cum interactive session for our volunteers like poetry writing, speaking Hindi and importance of Hindi Language, which is our National Language, etc. were held on this day. This session was very educative and knowledgeable for all of us. After the break, there was a presentation on Drug/Tobacco abuse by Dr. S.P. Surila (M.B.B.S, D.C.M. & H., ex Civil Surgeon, Mansa). He told us about various ill effects on use of drug/tobacco in our health. The presentation was very informative. After lunch, a documentary film "Roots of love" by Prof. Harjant Gill was shown. It is based on decreasing ratio of Sikh Youths in Punjab wearing turban today and increase in shedding of their hair. 

AWARENESS PROGRAM ON MENSTRUAL HYGIENE 17th January to 21st March, 2015

Students of NSS unit attended the Awareness program on Menstrual Hygiene. Students delivered talk on reproductive health & menstrual hygiene and about diet. We were delighted to see that the journal was highlighting this neglected component of adolescent health, including the increasing efforts worldwide to empower, educate, and engage country leaders, communities, families, and adolescent girls and boys about menstruation, and the rights of women and girls to hygienically, comfortably, and safely manage their periods.
