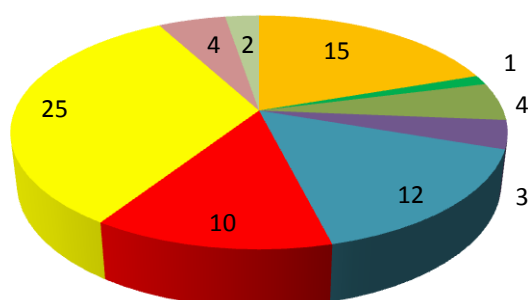

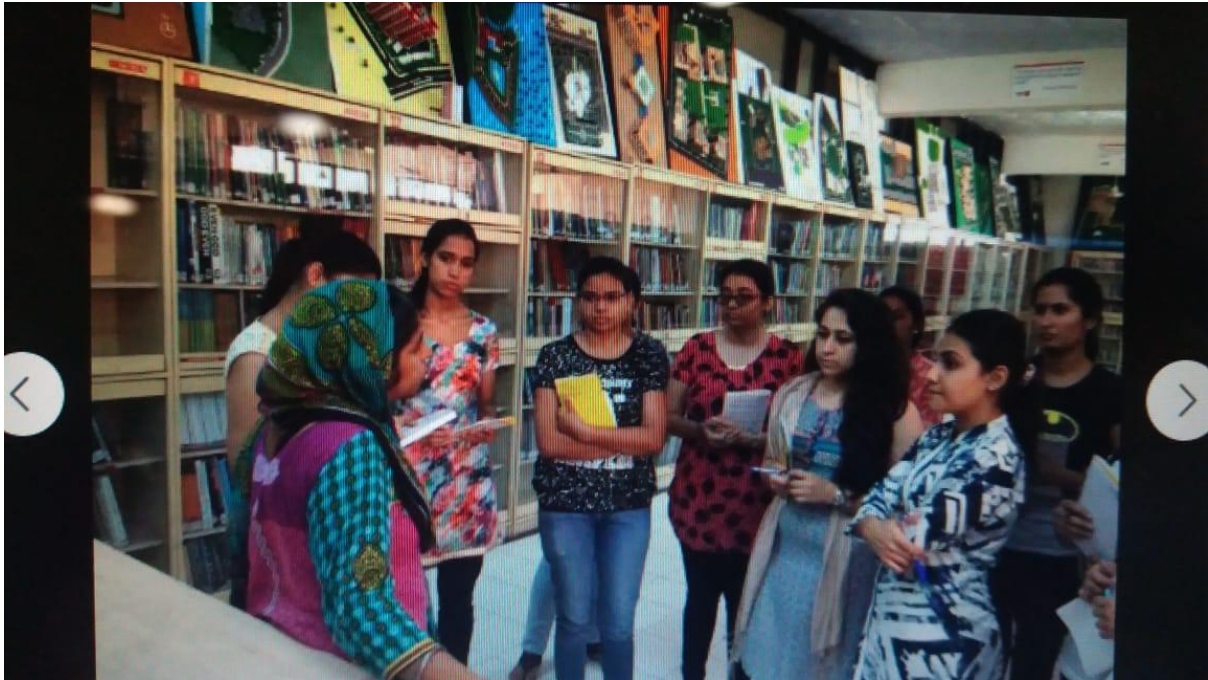

RADIO TALK: MALARIA PREVENTION

Date: 13 September, 2016

13 Students of B. Sc AHS gave a radio talk on "Malaria Prevention". The talk was aired at 4:00 pm, 13th September, 2016.

They also talked about four step approaches to prevention of malaria:

1. Awareness of the risk of malaria and the risk of complications associated with it is the first step in prevention. Travelers to areas with a high incidence of malaria need to be aware of their risk and take adequate precautions.
2. Prevention of mosquito bites. A single bite is enough to transmit malaria infection. Adequate protection against mosquito bites is important. Simple measures like wearing covered clothes, using a mosquito net and using an insect repellent helps in preventing bites. Complete avoidance of bites is not possible however the number of bites may be reduced as much as possible.
3. Anti-malaria tablets for prevention of infection. A complete course of prescribed medication before, during and after travel is important in prevention of acquiring infections. This is called chemoprophylaxis and is useful for travelers
4. Immediate diagnosis after onset of symptoms helps prevent complications of malaria. Symptoms could appear after a year after travelling and this need to be considered while diagnosing and treating malaria.

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RADIO TALK: DENGUE AWARENESS

Date: 15th March 2017

13 Students of B. Sc AHS gave a radio talk on "Dengue Awareness". The talk was recorded on 15th March, 2017. Points discussed by the students were:

Dos

- Relieve the pain and fever, use only paracetamol.
- Keep the baby well hydrated. Drink plenty of fluids — ORS, coconut water, fruit juices.
- Adequate bed rest.
- Consult a doctor and get admitted if not getting better.

Don'ts

- Do not use antibiotics, unless prescribed by doctor.
- Do not use steroids, unless prescribed by doctor.
- Avoid using Blood Transfusion or Platelets unless indicated

How can dengue be prevented:

- Avoid outdoor activities at Dawn and Dusk.
- Apply mosquito repellent creams on exposed skin before the kids move out of the house.
- Wear protective clothing. Cover as much of your skin by wearing light colored, loose, long sleeved shirts and pants. Avoid dark colors as they attract mosquitoes.
- Use bed nets for sleeping. Clothes and bed net can be sprayed with mosquito repellents.
- Use mosquito repellent coils or plug-in devices.
- Avoid mosquito breeding:
 - Get rid of stagnant water in pots, tyres, empty containers.
 - Cover all water storage tanks.
 - Empty out water cooler tanks every week.
 - Keep wet garbage covered. Empty out the dustbin daily.

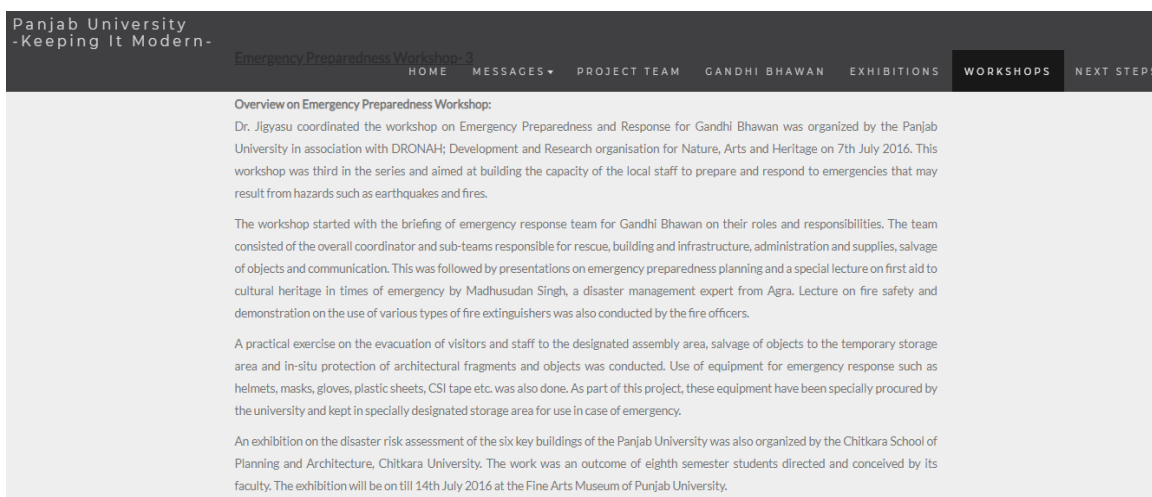

Dr. Jigyasu coordinated the workshop on Emergency Preparedness and Response for Gandhi Bhawan was organized by the Punjab University in association with DRONAH; Development and Research organisation for Nature, Arts and Heritage on 7th July 2016. This workshop was third in the series and aimed at building the capacity of the local staff to prepare and respond to emergencies that may result from hazards such as earthquakes and fires.

The workshop started with the briefing of emergency response team for Gandhi Bhawan on their roles and responsibilities. The team consisted of the overall coordinator and sub-teams responsible for rescue, building and infrastructure, administration and supplies, salvage of objects and communication. This was followed by presentations on emergency preparedness planning and a special lecture on first aid to cultural heritage in times of emergency by Madhusudan Singh, a disaster management expert from Agra. Lecture on fire safety and demonstration on the use of various types of fire extinguishers was also conducted by the fire officers.

A practical exercise on the evacuation of visitors and staff to the designated assembly area, salvage of objects to the temporary storage area and in-situ protection of architectural fragments and objects was conducted. Use of equipment for emergency response such as helmets, masks, gloves, plastic sheets, CSI tape etc. was also done. As part of this project, these equipment have been specially procured by the university and kept in specially designated storage area for use in case of emergency.

An exhibition on the disaster risk assessment of the six key buildings of the Panjab University was also organized by the Chitkara School of Planning and Architecture, Chitkara University. Chitkara school of planning 114 students of eighth semester students worked along with their faculty participated in the event . The exhibition will be on till 14th July 2016 at the Fine Arts Museum of Punjab University.

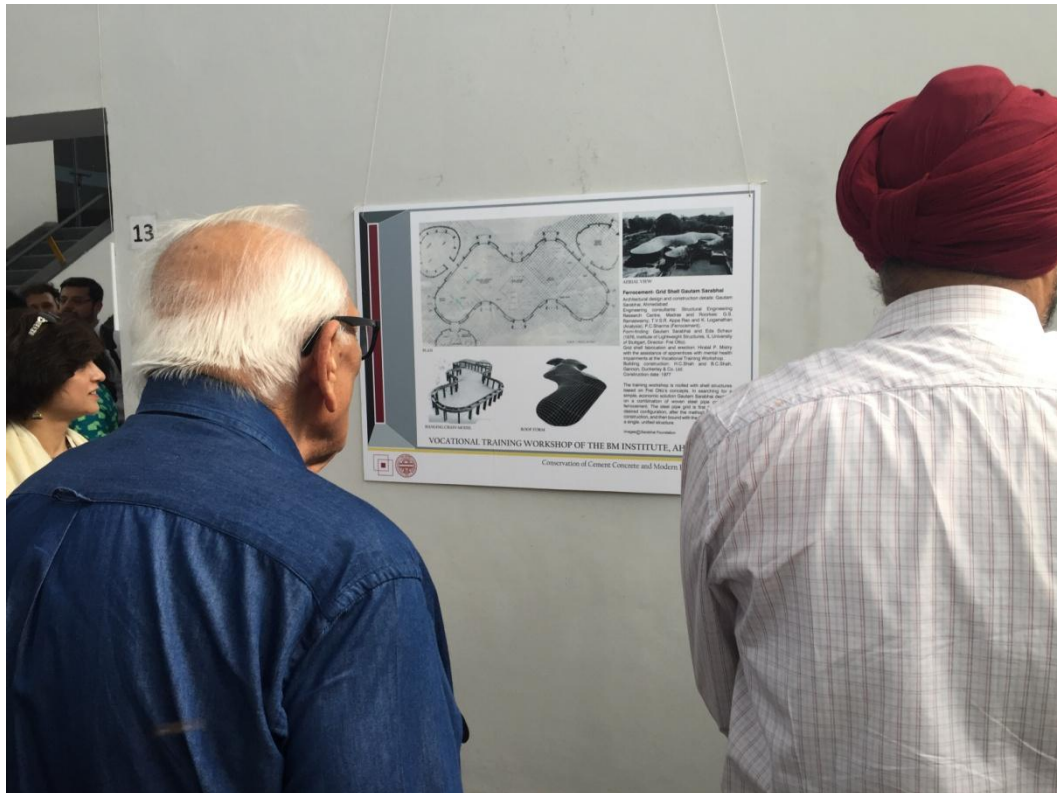

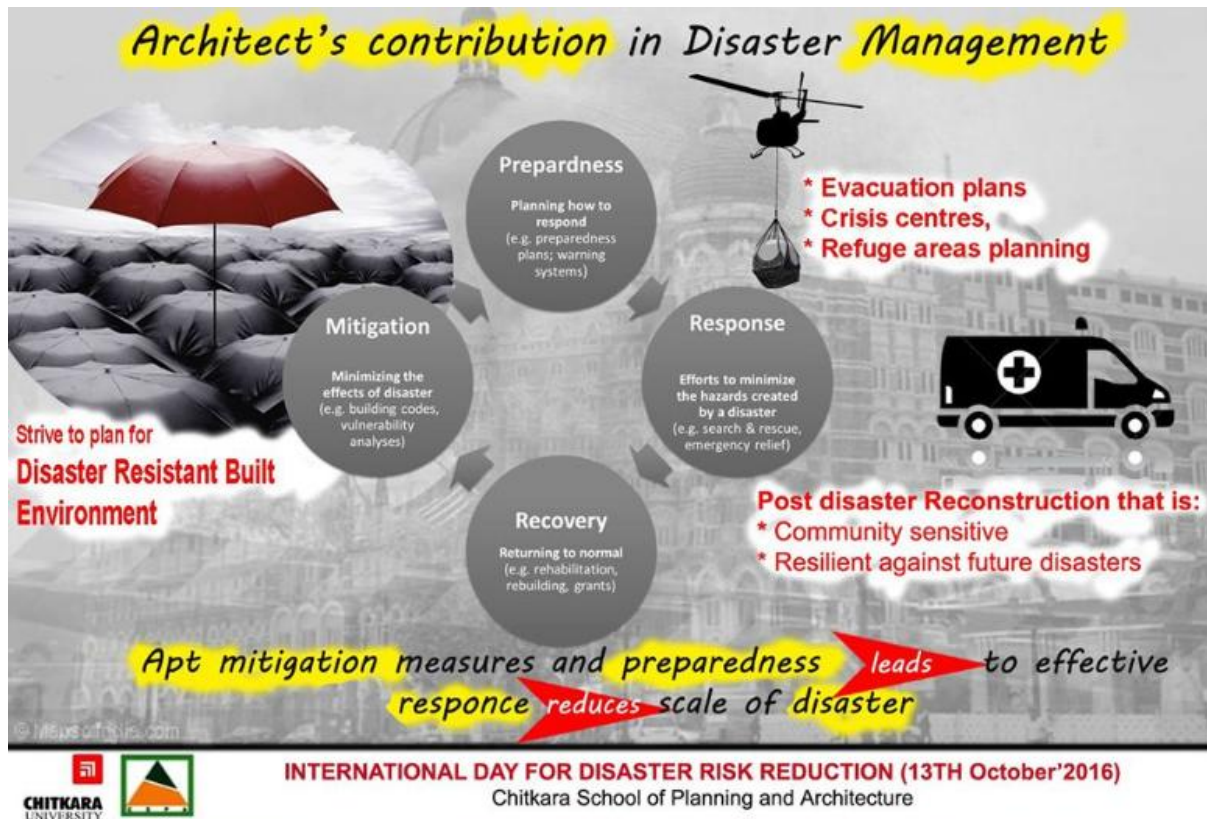

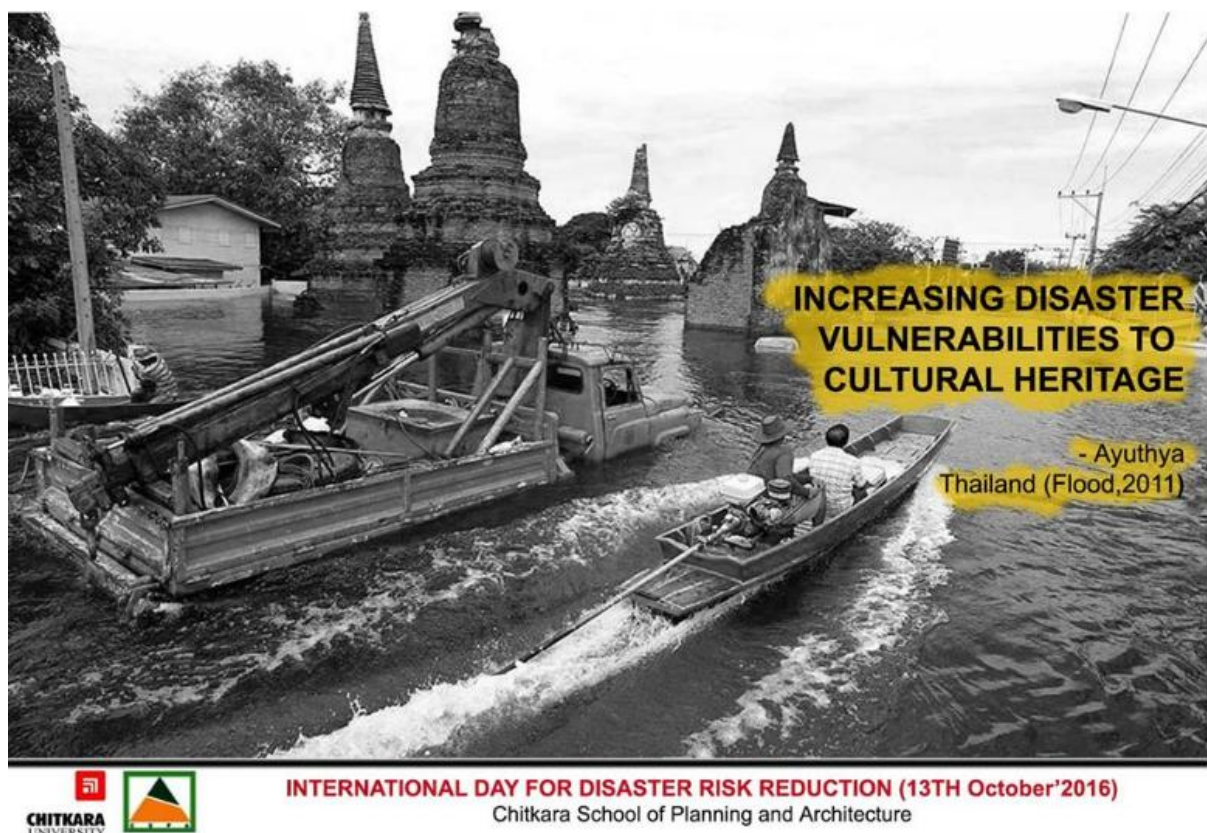

DOCUMENTING BUILDING OF HERITAGE VALUE IN BAGARIAN, NABHA, PUNJAB

Date: 01.03.2017 to 06.03.2017

While their juniors toured far off places, students from Sixth Semester and ten faculty members kept up the CSPA tradition of bringing to light the architectural gems of Punjab and embarked on a detailed documentation of the historic Bagarian Estate near Nabha. The Bagarian Documentation Project was shortlisted after assessing the historic potential and suitability of several sites in and around the erstwhile Princely City of Nabha. This was followed with obtaining relevant permissions and working out travel and stay logistics for the 110-member team. The total documentation site comprises two groups of buildings.

The first is centred on a "Garden House" constructed in 1905 for touring British officials, and includes a structure for their "Quarter Guards" and two separate Kitchens. The main building of the second group comprises a "Tutor's House" and a detached Kitchen that was built for the British Lady Tutor hired by the Bagarian family to educate their children in the Western ways.

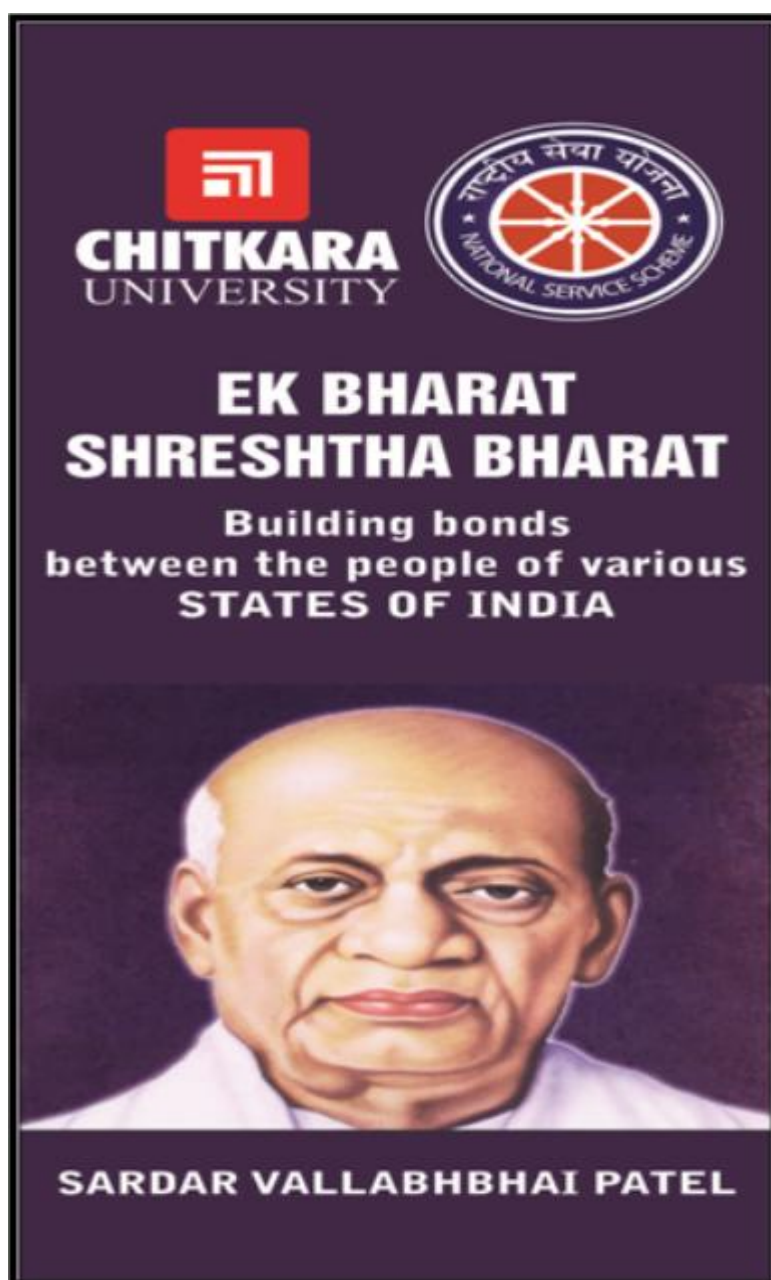

In the Spirit of Inter-State Cultural Connectivity of 'Ek Bharat Shreshta Bharat', Chitkara University, Punjab regularly conducts historical and cultural tours. A site-study was recently organized by the School of Planning and Architecture to sensitize students to various forms of the traditional built environment of Himachal Pradesh. The principal intention was to document and understand social, economic and technological processes that take place in areas where people design and build for their use. 25 NSS volunteers participated in the activity. The study was based in the villages of Naggar, Sharan and Rumsu located in Naggar Tehsil, Kullu, Himachal Pradesh. The aim was to document the settlements in their setting, using various modes of media such as drawings, photography and video recording, with students engaging themselves with the community for four days, to have a holistic understanding of the place and its people. Detailed documentation especially focused on the vernacular house form, its response to the climate, local building materials and the residents' lifestyle. The houses were built in the region's typical "Kath-Kuni Construction System. The study also included photo documentation of the ancient art and architecture of Himachal Pradesh such as metal sculpture woodcarvings, stone carvings, paintings and the four forms of old temples- Pent roof or chalet style, the Tower style, the Pyramidal style and the Pagoda style -- that are scattered all along the mountain slopes and the valleys. All the above four types of temples are well represented in Naggar and the students did a trek studying all the four temples one by one.

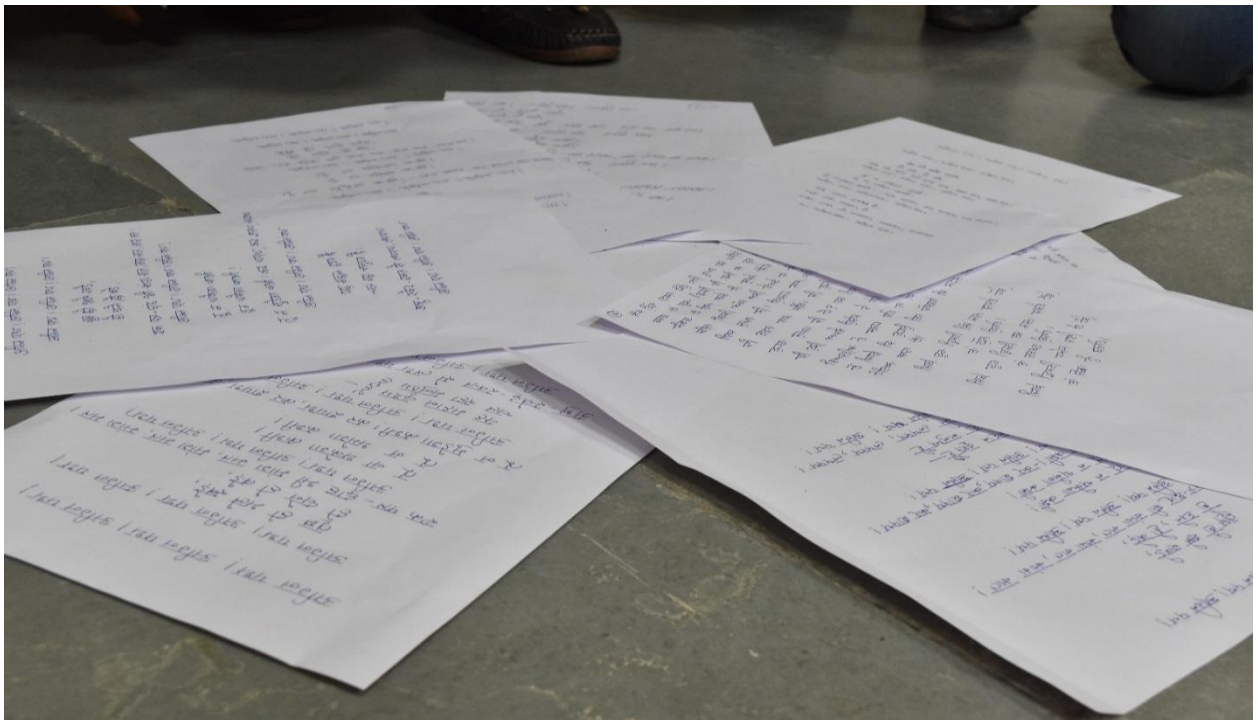

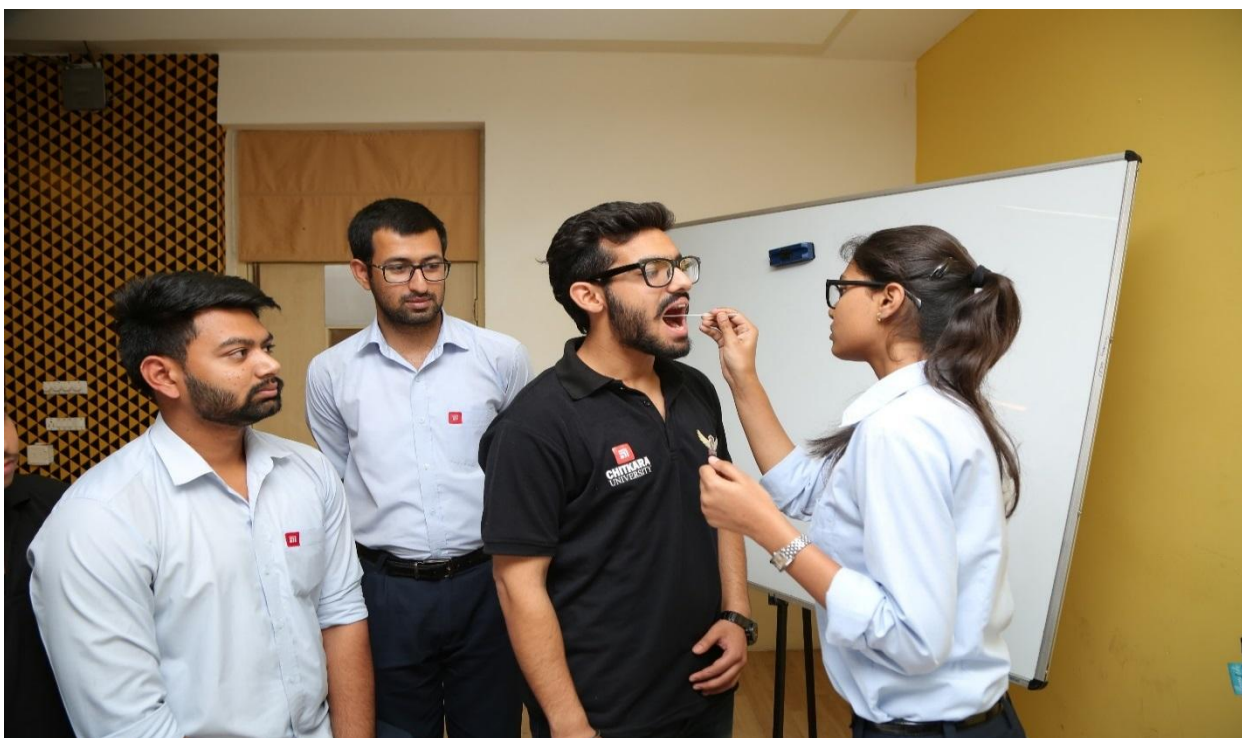

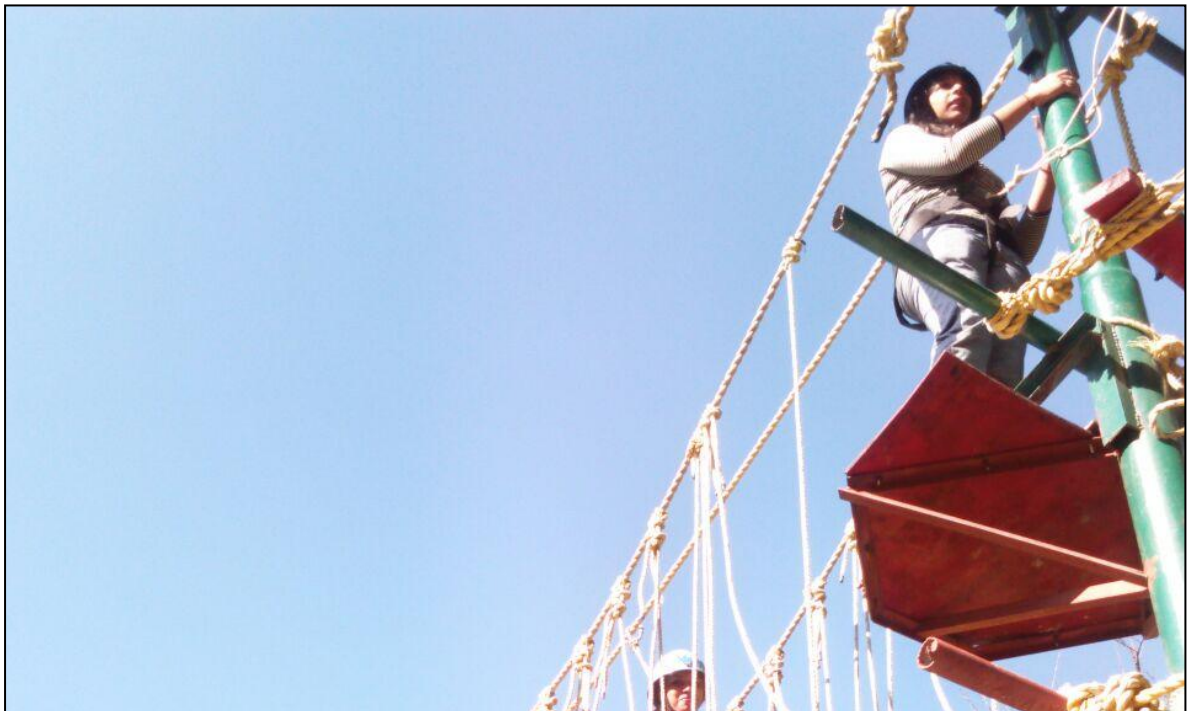
