As part of Architecture Design Studio, students of 6th Semester B.Arch. of Chitkara School of Planning and Architecture (CSPA), have taken up a project aimed at 'Rural Development Plan- Fatehpur Garhi village, located nearby Chitkara University, Punjab. The project is being conducted under the supervision of a team of faculty members, namely Ar. Shruti Behera, Ar. Pradeep Singh maan, Ar. Shaffali Joshi, Ar. Aarti Rana, and, Ar. Prayashi Baruah, along with visiting Faculty Ar. Chanpreet Singh, Ar. Aman preet Sohal, Ar. Ravipreet Sandhu. Total 117 students of 6th semester batch 2015 were indulged in the activity.

The objective of the project, thus, is to sensitize CSPA students to the ground reality of India's rural environments and to build special attitudes and skills for creating appropriate, context-responsive designs for such situations. The project continued till the end of the current semester and comprises various stages, such as identifying unique attributes of the chosen case study, i.e., Fatehpur Garhi, through study and documentation of its settlement pattern, design and usage of public/open spaces, design of various types of buildings, construction systems, etc., as well as detailed household surveys and other forms of interaction to identify need-based development issues within the village. The results would be analysed for formulation of design project (s). The project would end with various Design Proposals.



DOCUMENTING THE HISTORIC CITY OF NARNAUL, PUNJAB Date: 11-Feb-2018 to 18-Feb-2018

The students at CSPA had been continuously working on to bring the light to the architectural gems of the north zone. This year, a new group of budding architects from 6th semester worked on the city of Narnaul (Haryana) under the guidance of 8 faculty members and our Dean, Prof. Kiran joshi. The intent and the scale of the project was to document the entire city of narnaul where the students have prepared the inventories of all the historic buildings in the city including various building typologies. Later on the detailed documentation work was carried out on 8 different sites. The intent was to understand the traditional water management systems and the residential structures built in response to the climate of the region.

8 ds intensive site exercise was carried out with an aim to create awareness, sharing stories and transferring the knowledge between generations. The students and faculties were divided into eight groups where they worked on different sites and prepared the measured drawings for 4 havelis (residential structures) and 8 water structures. The work done on the site is now under the process of being completed in the form of detailed drawings which will add on to the CSPA's database of unknown architectural heritage of the North zone. 117 Students of 6th semester batch 215 were indulged in the activity.

EXHIBITION LEARNING FROM THE LEGACY OF HISTORIC TOWN NARNAUL Date: 18-April-2018

In keeping with Chitkara University's mandate of inculcating "Pride for our heritage in our students", Chitkara School of Planning and Architecture undertook an annual exercise of documenting the lesser-known historic buildings and towns of our region and, then displayed the work done on the 18th April, a day celebrated the world over as the "International Day for Monuments and Sites" or the "World Heritage Day". 117 students 2015 batch participated the event. 




