Session 2011-12. Chitkara University has been established under Punjab Pvt. University policy 2010 by the State Govt. vide State Act no. 23 of 2010. The College has been accredited 'A' Grade with a CGPA of 3.14 on a 4 point scale by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore.**

ABOUT NAAC

The **NATIONAL ASSESSMENT AND ACCREDITATION COUNCIL (NAAC), Bangalore** is an autonomous body established by the University Grants Commission (UGC) of India to assess and accredit institutions of higher education in the country. It is an outcome of the recommendations of the National Policy in Education (1986) that lays special emphasis in upholding the quality of higher education in India. To address the issues of quality, the National Policy on Education (1986) and the Plan of Action (POA-1992) advocated the establishment of an independent national accreditation body. Consequently, the NAAC was established in 1994 with its headquarters at Bangalore.
